

The regulations carry out the publication and application of this guideline indicated in 45/f article of the law with law number 6287 and “Regulations for International Students Admission” shown by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). The applicants are considered to agree with the regulations indicated on the guideline and the related legislation. Explanations and announcements concerning the application and admission process are published on the website of Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University (AYBU) OİDB, and the announcement in question has the force of announcement to the candidates.

The application fee indicated in the guideline is determined by the AYBU Administrative Committee and announced to the public through the AYBU website. Application centers, banks, mediator institutions, etc., **can not** demand any fee from the applicants except for the amount indicated on the AYBU website. AYBU International Students Admission Process is done directly, without any mediator, and online only through the university's website. The applicants have to pay only the amount indicated in the guideline. The candidates who do not apply, those with invalid applications, those who make payment for any process that does not require payment, and those who make payment more than once **are not** paid back the fee they have paid. The candidates are responsible for paying the fees to the correct account. 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## WHY AYBU?

## ACCEPTANCE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION

Application and admission procedures of International Students to short-cycle and bachelor programs of Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University (AYBU) for the 2024-2025 Academic Year are carried out by the regulations indicated on 45/f article of the law with law number 2547 and “*Regulations for International Students Admission*” indicated by Council of Higher Education (YÖK).

## APPLICATIONS

### WHO CAN APPLY?

On condition that they are registered to their final year in high school or being a high school graduate;

- 1) Those who have hold of foreign nationality (Schoolers who got their high school education in Türkiye have to have registered before the Academic Year of 2022-2023.) [Excluding Embassy Schools, International Private Teaching Institutions featured in MOBİS system, and those with foreign nationalities that have been brought to Türkiye by Ministry of National Education within the framework of a project]
- 2) Those who have the birthright citizenship of Türkiye who have lost their citizenship by getting permission from the Ministry of Interior and those who can certify that they have taken the **(Blue Card)** via their demands. (Schoolers who got their high school education in Türkiye must have registered before the Academic Year of 2022-2023.) \*  
*\*In the 7th article of Turkish Citizenship Law with law number 5901, the force “The child of a Turkish mother or father born in or out of Türkiye within the union of marriage is a Turkish Citizen” is included. Applicants applying for AYBU from the international students’ quota are kindly advised to examine Turkish Citizenship Law.*
- 3) Foreign nationals who became Turkish Citizens afterward are dual citizens in the same status. (Schoolers who got their high school education in Türkiye must have registered before the Academic Year of 2022-2023.)
- 4) Turkish nationals who completed high school in a foreign country (except for the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus), including Turkish high schools, work under the legacy of the Turkish Ministry of Education.
- 5) Those with KKTC nationality who reside in KKTC, have completed their high school education in KKTC, and have the General Certificate of Education advanced level (GCE-AL), and those who have the GCE-AL certificate or are bound to have one by having applied to colleges and high schools abroad and getting an education there between 2005 and 2010.

Their applications to appropriate AYBU’s 2024-2025 Academic Year Graduate and Undergraduate Programs announced with this guide are accepted.

### WHO CANNOT APPLY?

- 1) Turkish nationals who have completed their entire secondary education in Türkiye or Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus,
- 2) Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus nationals (excluding the ones who completed their entire secondary education there having GCE-AL Certificate and those who are registered to high schools in other countries between the years 2005-2010 and hold and will hold GCE-AL certificate soon),

- 3) Dual citizens who have Turkish citizenship by birth (excluding the ones whose condition is similar to the ones indicated in the “4’t’h” article of the list of the ones who can apply indicated above),
- 4) Dual citizens who have a Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus Citizenship by birth (excluding the ones who completed their entire secondary education there having GCE-AL Certificate and those who are registered to high schools in other countries between the years 2005-2010 and hold or will have hold of GCE-AL certificate soon),
- 5) Turkish nationals or dual citizens who have Turkish citizenship by birth and are getting education in foreign high schools or high schools that are a constitution of the embassies in Türkiye,
- 6) Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus citizens who have registered to secondary education institutions in Türkiye as of the 2022-2023 Academic year and those who have lost their Turkish citizenships/Blue card holders and foreign nationals[Excluding Embassy Schools, International Private Teaching Institutions featured in MOBİS system and those with foreign nationalities that have been brought to Türkiye by Ministry of National Education within the framework of a project]

**Applications are not accepted** for international student quotas announced in this guide for AYBU's associate and undergraduate programs for the 2024-2025 academic year.

## **APPLICATION TYPES AND QUOTAS**

Candidates with the necessary conditions for application can apply to become an international student at AYBU in one of the categories indicated below with proper conditions for them. Please see Table 1 at the end of the guide for **the quotas and tuition fees** of AYBU's 2024-2025 Academic year associate degree and undergraduate programs.

**The quota for International Students:** This is the quota for candidates with a single foreign nationality or those born with a foreign nationality who later acquired Turkish nationality.

**The quota for YTB High Schools:** This is the type of quota for which graduates of High Schools announced by the Presidency for Turks Abroad and Related Communities can apply. (Those holding Turkish Republic citizenship must submit their entrance and exiting papers during the application process.)

**Blue Card Quota:** This is the quota for “Blue Card” holders who were Turkish citizens by birth but ceased their citizenship later on and before graduating from high school, with the permission of Turkish Nationality Law no 5901 article 28. The Republic of Turkish Ministry of Internal Affairs General Directorate of Population and Citizenship Affairs hands out this card.

**The quota for Turkish Citizens who received High School Education Abroad:** This is the quota for those who are Turkish Citizens or double citizens (one of which is Turkish citizenship) and completed their high school education abroad. (This is the quota type for those whose condition is indicated in article “4” above.) (Entrance and exiting papers to Türkiye must be submitted during the application process.)

**The quota for KKTC citizens:** By the decision of our University Senate dated 06/07/2023 and numbered 2023/13/15 within the scope of the protocol signed between our Rectorate and TRNC Ministry of National Education on 13/07/2023, this is the quota to be applied by candidates who are TRNC citizens and have taken or will take the GCE AL exam.

*The ECTS and credits of the courses at AYBU are determined in accordance with the workload in the direction of the course outcomes. Thanks to recognition criteria such as Diploma Supplement and ECTS, vocational and academic mobility is intended to be enhanced by the recognition of the education our students receive at AYBU abroad.*

**ATTENTION!** Candidates must meet the relevant conditions for the quota type they apply for. Those with T.R. Citizenship as one of their nationality must declare the relevant information during the application process. Candidates with Turkish citizenship but do not declare this status during their application will not be registered. Candidates with dual nationality are required to declare both nationalities during the application. Candidates whose applications have been pre-examined and approved by the OİDB cannot update their passport and/or identity information, and their transactions continue based on the information and documents they have declared.

## **DEMANDED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION\***

When applying online, candidates must upload the documents listed below to the system **as scanned documents**. The language of these documents may be either in Turkish or in English. Applications and/or placement procedures of candidates whose application documents and application quota types need to be added or corrected will be deemed invalid even if they have gained the right to register, and their registration will not be made.

- 1) Biometrical photo (*It should be taken within six months. Photos unsuitable for this statement are considered not submitted. If the applicant is accepted to the program, this photo will be on their ID cards.*)
- 2) The pages of the unexpired passport contain the identity information and the photo (*Those with the right to register will also be asked to provide the page with the valid visa at the time of registration.*)
- 3) High school diploma and its apostille-approved translation into Turkish (*Those who do not have a high school diploma may submit a Temporary Graduation Certificate. The document showing the graduation grade and the version of their high school diplomas that shows equivalency to the ones taken in Turkish high schools and an "Equivalence Certificate" that can be taken from either the T.R. Ministry of National Education or Turkish embassies that reside in the applicant's country will be requested during the final registration process.*)
- 4) High School Transcript and Apostille-certified Turkish translation that the High School Management approves,
- 5) Certificate for one of the valid shown in Table 2 that proves the candidate has at least the minimum score for the application
- 6) ID information that verifies the application type,
- 7) Bank receipt showing that the application fee has been paid **on behalf of the candidate**,
- 8) A document stating that the first nationality of dual nationals is not Turkish. (A copy of the certificate of identity register must be uploaded to the system by the deadline.)
- 9) This is the entrance and exiting document to our country for candidates who are citizens of the Republic of Türkiye and have completed their high school education in a foreign country other than the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. (It can be obtained through the e-Devlet Gateway at [turkiye.gov.tr](http://turkiye.gov.tr).)
- 10) Certificate of renouncement of Turkish citizenship for those who do not have a Blue Card among Turkish citizens by birth but lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining an existing permit.
- 11) Language certificate that shows adequacy to the education language of the applied program, if available.

*\* Candidates who do not have a high school diploma, provisional graduation certificate and / or valid exam results showing that they have the minimum score and the numerical equivalent of the letter grades in their certificates must submit a document showing the numerical equivalents of the letter grades.*

**ATTENTION!** The ID cards on which there is no updated photo of the candidate and the passports with the expired date of validity are not accepted in the application process. The candidates are supposed to complete their application process by carrying out it in the direction of "Guideline to Fill in Online Application Form for International Students" on the AYBU website within the application time and pay the application fee. **The online Application System will be inaccessible by the July 05, 2024 at 23.59 local time in Türkiye.**

## APPLICATION FEE

The candidates should pay the application fee within the application period using the information submitted on their passports or ID cards. The candidates interested in paying the application fee by going to the bank must tell the bank officer that they will pay the application fee along with the ID number they have submitted. The candidates need to check whether the information on the receipt, such as ID number, name and surname, and name of the application (AYBU 2024-2025 Academic Year International Student Application), belongs to them and keep the receipt to upload to the Online Application System. Candidates applying in Türkiye can pay the application fee via internet banking.

Candidates may pay the application fee until **July 05, 2024** at 5 p.m. local time in Türkiye. Candidates who will pay abroad are advised that **bank transfers may take some time**.

## HOW TO MAKE AN APPLICATION?

Here are the steps to be followed by the candidates who are interested in making an application to short-cycle and bachelor programs of AYBU from the international student quota in the 2024-2025 academic year:

1. To carefully read the “Guideline of Application for International Students for 2024-2025 Academic Year” announced on the website of AYBU OİDB (<https://aybu.edu.tr/>),
2. Candidates can access **the Application Form** from the online application system on the AYBU website, [https://obs.aybu.edu.tr/oibs/foa\\_app/](https://obs.aybu.edu.tr/oibs/foa_app/), within the application period. Applications are made only through this online system, and the candidates can make their applications online individually. Explanations for filling in the form can be obtained from the announcement section.
3. Candidates can choose **up to two (2)** programs according to their exam/diploma type and score.
4. It is sufficient for the candidates to submit only one exam with a higher score from the exams given in the Table and still valid, in order of priority, to the "Exams" section of the application form. Exams other than the exam score to be evaluated during the control phase are not considered.
5. The application will be completed after the candidate pays the application fee. However, the application of those who do not make the payment on time and upload the information to the system will be invalid.
6. The AYBU Directorate of Student Affairs controls the appropriateness of the candidates’ documents uploaded to the system. If no document is missing from the application and the candidate meets the demanded conditions, the system approves the application. Applications of candidates whose status is indicated as “wrong/missing document” in the system are not considered until they upload the demanded document.

7. The status of the applications of candidates who do not have application conditions or who do not upload their missing documents within the application period is indicated as “refused” in the system, and their applications are not considered.

**ATTENTION!** The candidate is responsible for any changes or copies of the application information and any errors or omissions that may arise after the application is approved. Candidates who are in the high school class and are still studying or waiting are required to provide this score during registration. If this is not achieved, registration will not be made even if the candidates have the right to register. Applications of candidates who submit inappropriate information and documents will be cancelled. If the candidate is granted the right to register, he/she will be asked to bring the originals of the uploaded documents. Original documents will go through verification.

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE APPLICATION RESULTS

The application results are announced in the “Announcement” section of the AYBU OİDB website. The announcement on the website has a quality of notification, and the candidates will not be sent any results. The candidate will find their application results on the AYBU website [https://obs.aybu.edu.tr/oibs/foa\\_app/](https://obs.aybu.edu.tr/oibs/foa_app/), along with their ID numbers and passwords. They will see one of the below statements as the result of their application:

- a) You have not been entitled to the right to registration.
- b) You have the right to registration.
- c) You have been entitled to the right to registration as a substitute.

The candidates entitled to registration are sent a “Letter of Acceptance” via the online application system to register with AYBU. **If any of these candidates do not apply for registration, the candidates announced as substitutes are entitled to registration. For this reason, the candidates are kindly advised to follow the announcements on the AYBU OİDB website.**

Among the candidates who have the right to enroll in our university, those who have formally registered students at the same level in other higher education institutions in our country must have been deregistered from those institutions when applying for registration to our University.

Candidates whose pre-evaluation results are positive for applications to programs accepting students through the Special Aptitude Exam must be successful in the exceptional talent exam conducted by AYBU to gain the right to final registration. The "Acceptance Letter" sent to these candidates whose applications have been approved is temporary, and the final registration right will be given if they are successful in the "Special Aptitude Exam" to be held by the relevant academic unit.

## ASSESSMENT

### HOW TO ASSESS APPLICATIONS?

The candidates who apply for associate degrees and undergraduate programs of AYBU for the 2024-2025 academic year from the quota of international students are subjected to a two-phased assessment process in the directions of the steps listed below.

#### 1. Pre-Assessment of the Application Document

- a) All candidates are assessed by the “*Application Type*” quota they have applied to. The status of the applications of the candidates who do not submit a document regarding the application type is indicated as “*Inappropriate/Missing Document*”.
- b) The status of the applications of the candidates who upload their documents thoroughly and

adequately is indicated as “Approved”.

- c) The application status of the candidates who do not meet the requirements is indicated as “Refused”.
- d) After the application status is changed, information is sent to the e-mail addresses provided by the candidates in the form as “Your application status has changed”. Candidates are responsible for following their application status on the ‘Online Application System’ and paying attention to the warnings in the explanation section.

**ATTENTION!** Due to the busyness of the application dates in the last week, the application evaluations may be delayed until the deadline. Since the applications of the candidates may be rejected in case of an incorrect/missing part in their application, it will be in the best interest of the candidate not to leave the applications to the last days. In case there is uncertainty with the documents submitted during the application process, the department that carries out the pre-assessment process may request additional documents.

## 2. Assessment of the Applications

Quotas are distributed according to nationality for placement in programs. Placement results are announced on the AYBU Student Affairs Department’s web page. **Table 2**, which includes **the exams to be considered** in the evaluation of applications and **the minimum scores** to be accepted, is at the end of this guide.

The candidates approved on the online application system are assessed by the steps listed below, considering their high school diploma scores, one of the scores indicated in Table 2 (if available), their program preference and quotas, and the conditions of these programs per country. Those who are successful in the ranking are placed in the related program in line with their preference.

- a) In placements to the relevant program, priority is given to candidates with the exam result documents specified in Table 2-A, within the quota distribution according to nationality.
- b) After these candidates are placed, the remaining quotas are filled according to Table 2-B, considering the quota distribution according to nationality.
- c) If a vacant quota remains after these placements are completed, candidate placement is made according to Table 2-C, considering the quota distribution according to country nationality.
- d) During the evaluation, if the candidates' diploma/exam scores are equal, priority is given according to their language proficiency certificate score, if there is any. To see **if our university accepts the language exams as equivalents**, please review the language equivalence table in the helpful information section of this guide.
- e) Candidates who have applied to departments or programs that accept students through a particular talent exam and have met the pre-admission conditions are evaluated according to their success in the exceptional talent exam, which the relevant Faculty/Conservatory will hold.
- f) AYBU is entirely responsible for evaluating applications and placing candidates. After the registration process is completed, AYBU can make additional placements in the vacant quotas due to the non-registration of candidates entitled to enroll in the programs or the absence of an applicant and to change the evaluation criteria specified in the table in these placements.
- g) Meeting the application requirements does not guarantee acceptance into the program. AYBU is free to fill out or not fill out the quotas.
- h) Meeting the application requirements does not guarantee acceptance into the program. AYBU is free to fill out or not fill out the quotas.



## USEFUL INFORMATION

### EDUCATION – INSTRUCTION LANGUAGE

Below are listed the language certificates accepted at our university, language exemption exams, opportunities, and information about the preparatory courses. The language of education of our University is also indicated according to the departments in the quota table.

Language proficiency must be documented according to the language of instruction of the programs applied for. Candidates who do not have a valid language certificate must meet the conditions stated below. However, **candidates who have studied at secondary education institutions attended by citizens of that country in a country where the foreign language determined as the language of instruction is spoken as their mother tongue** for at least the last three years and **completed their secondary education in these institutions** are considered exempt from the relevant foreign language.

### English

If the candidates are accepted, those who do not have English language proficiency must take the proficiency and placement exams organized by our University's School of Foreign Languages, which are announced on <https://aybu.edu.tr/yabancidiller/>. You can contact our University's School of Foreign Languages to learn the relevant exam dates and get detailed information.

For programs where the language of instruction is partially or entirely English, those who can document that they have received sufficient scores from the internationally valid exams listed below or the Foreign Language Exemption Exam (YDMS) conducted by our University have the right to start the relevant program directly. The results of YDMS-equivalent international exams held in Turkey, whose sessions are not held in public university buildings and whose result documents do not contain exam location and date information, are not considered equivalent. Please review the table below for the validity period of these exams and their equivalency accepted by the Senate of our University.

## Turkish

Turkish Proficiency Certificate received from AYBU DİLMER, Yunus Emre Institute, or from one of the centers recognized by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) within **the last two years** is accepted for candidates who apply for programs whose language of instruction is 100% Turkish, 30% English, or 30% Arabic to certify their language proficiency before registration. If the candidates with the certificate in question are admitted, they can start directly from the related program without attending the prep class.

A Turkish Proficiency Certificate is not required when applying for programs that provide education entirely in a foreign language. However, students must submit **the B1 Turkish Proficiency Certificate** until graduation. In addition, students entitled to enroll in the Faculty of Medicine's Medicine (English) program must submit the C1 Turkish Proficiency Certificate to their Faculties before they can register for courses in **the 4th year**. To start the Translation and Interpretation (English) and Information and Document Management Programs,



candidates must have Turkish speaking and writing skills at **the C2 level**. If candidates who do not have Turkish language proficiency are accepted, they must take the proficiency and level determination exams held by AYBÜ DİLMER and announced at <https://aybu.edu.tr/dilmer/>. You can contact AYBÜ DİLMER to learn the relevant exam dates and get detailed information. Candidates who do not speak Turkish will receive training in Turkish preparation courses conducted at DİLMER.



### IMPORTANT NOTE!

- \* Annual fees declared in dollars are converted into Turkish lira at the Central Bank foreign exchange selling rate of the first business day, one week before the registration date of those entitled to registration in the main list, and paid in two installments. The first installment is made at the time of registration to the University. The second installment is paid on the spring semester tuition fee payment dates announced in the AYBU 2024-2025 Academic Year calendar. In subsequent years, tuition fees converted into Turkish lira at the Central Bank foreign exchange selling rate of the first business day one week before the fall and spring semester tuition fee payment dates in the relevant academic calendar are paid on a semester basis.
- \* If the amount resulting from the conversion to Turkish lira is lower than the minimum fees announced by the relevant decision of the President published in the Official Gazette for the relevant academic year, the minimum fee announced in the Presidential decision is charged.
- \* Students who exceed the normal education period pay tuition fees for the following semesters with a 30% increase over the amount converted into Turkish lira.
- \* If the tuition fee needs to be refunded, the amount converted into Turkish lira at the foreign exchange rate is taken as a reference, and the refund is made in Turkish lira.
- \* In the 5th Paragraph of Article 3 of the "Decision on the Determination of Contribution Fees and Tuition Fees to be Received as Student Contribution to Current Service Costs in Higher Education Institutions in the 2023-2024 Academic Year" published in the Official Gazette No. 32249 states that "Determined by the Presidency of Turks Abroad and Related Communities (YTB) Tuition fee of the students who graduated from educational institutions abroad that have equivalence to the high schools within the body of The Ministry of Education, Turkish Religious Foundation, Turkish Education Foundation; international religious vocational high schools, Minority High Schools, that offer education in the frame of religious vocational high school student programs carried out within the cooperation of The Ministry of Education and Turkish Religious Foundation and education institutions in the status of religious vocational high schools that offer education within the body of Muslim Religious Administrations and do registration to short-cycle and bachelor programs from international students admission quota in accordance with the interest of the student is the amount shown on the table (i) and (ii) attached to this decision". In the frame of the paragraph in question, the tuition fee that needs to be paid by the students who continue their education in daytime education or distance education or the students who will be registered to these programs is paid from the budget of YTB on behalf of these students during the normal period of the program.

**See 1:** The Cooperation Protocol signed between the TRNC Ministry of National Education and TR Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University on July 13, 2023, involves only TRNC national students.

**See 2:** Candidates who do not have a C1 Turkish Certificate can take the Turkish Proficiency Exam delivered by AYBU DİLMER and obtain the demanded certificate if they succeed. Candidates who do not have a C1 Level Turkish Certificate must attend the Turkish Prep Class of DİLMER. Please visit this link for the details of DİLMER: <https://www.aybu.edu.tr/dilmer/>.

**See 3:** Candidates who do not have an English Proficiency Certificate can take the English Proficiency Exam delivered by the AYBU School of Foreign Languages and, if they succeed, obtain the certificate they desire. Candidates who fail the exam must attend an English Prep Class.

**See 4:** Education (except for the preparatory class) will be on the Tuz Gölü Campus.

**See 5:** One-year English Prep Class is compulsory. After the end of the prep class, those who succeed in the English Prep Class are registered for the first class of the program in which they are placed. Prep Class is not included in the year indicated as the period of education column of the program. Candidates with one of the certificates recognized by AYBU (shown below) start from the first class. The students are subjected to the legislation of "Regulation for Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education Institutions and Criteria that Need to be Considered in The Application of Teaching Foreign Language" of AYBU. According to this regulation, two groups of students will be regarded as successful in certifying their English Proficiency.

- a) Those who can certify that they have received proficiency in one of the national/international language proficiency exams recognized by the university;
- b) Those who succeed in the English Proficiency Exam that the university delivers at the beginning of the academic year.

**See 6:** One-year Arabic Prep Class is compulsory. Prep Class is not included in the year indicated as the period of education column of the program. Those who succeed in the Arabic Prep Class are registered to the program's first class in which they are placed. The students are subjected to the legislation of "Regulation for Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education Institutions and Criteria that Need to be Considered in The Application of Teaching Foreign Language."

**See 7:** The students who register for this program must wear the uniforms their profession requires in the applied courses.

**See 8:** The candidates who will prefer this program have to have these conditions to be able to practice their profession:

- 1) Not to have any criminal record.
- 2) The female candidates must be between 160 cm-180 cm (weighing more than 5 kilograms or less than 15 kilograms of the last two digits of the value of the height in centimeters).
- 3) The male candidates must be between 170 cm and 190 cm (weighing more than 5 kilograms or less than 15 kilograms of the last two digits of the height value in centimeters).
- 4) Being in good health for the flight (They must receive reports from health institutions authorized by the Civil Aviation General Directorate that their health status is appropriate for the flight.).
- 5) No tattoos, scars, etc., on the visible parts of the body when wearing the cabin crew uniform.


