

Setting up AYBU WiFi for Windows 7

1. In the System tray, click on the signal bar icon as shown in Figure 1.

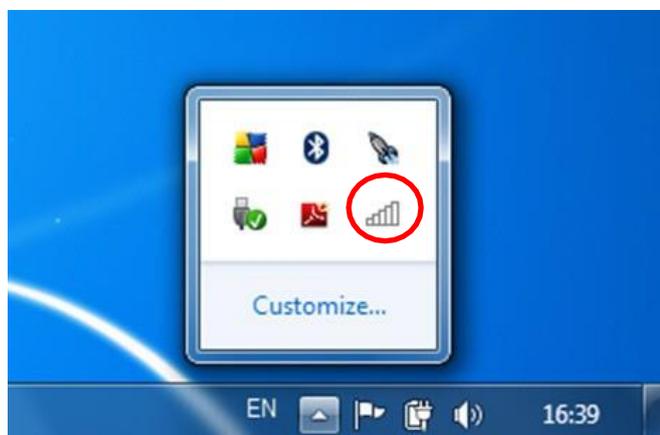

2. On the “Currently connected to:” pop-up, click on “Open Network and Sharing Center” as shown in Figure 2.

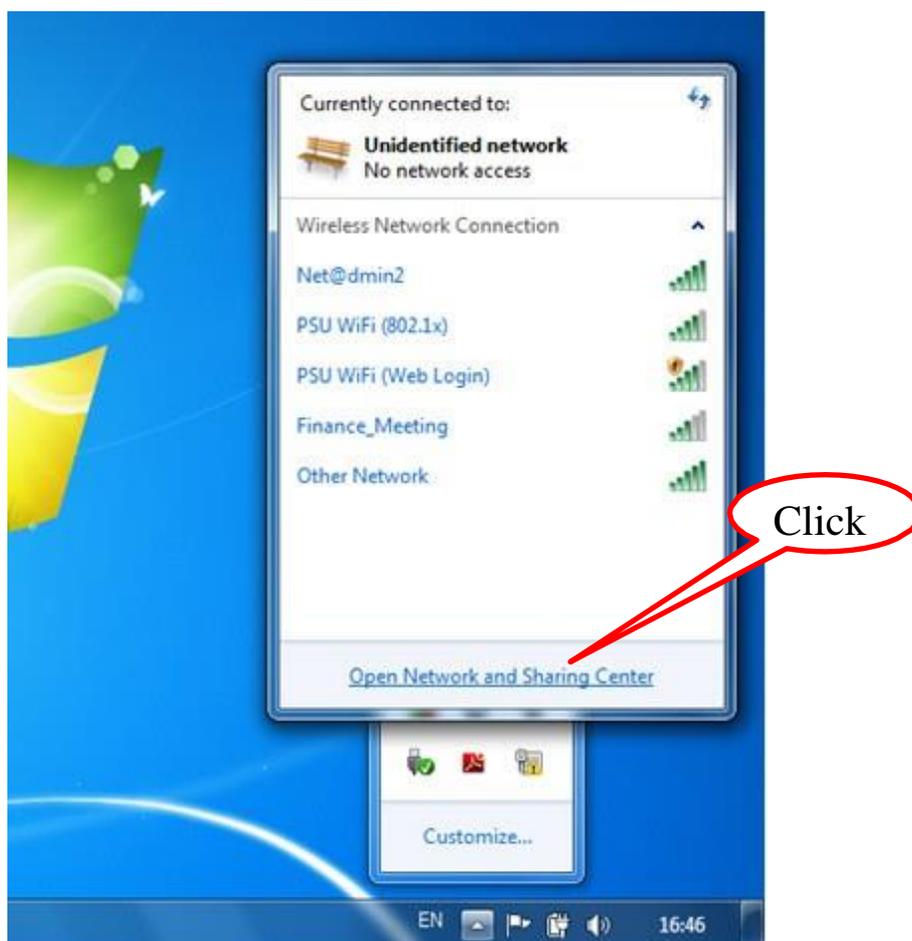

3. On the resulting window, click on “Set up a new connection or network”.

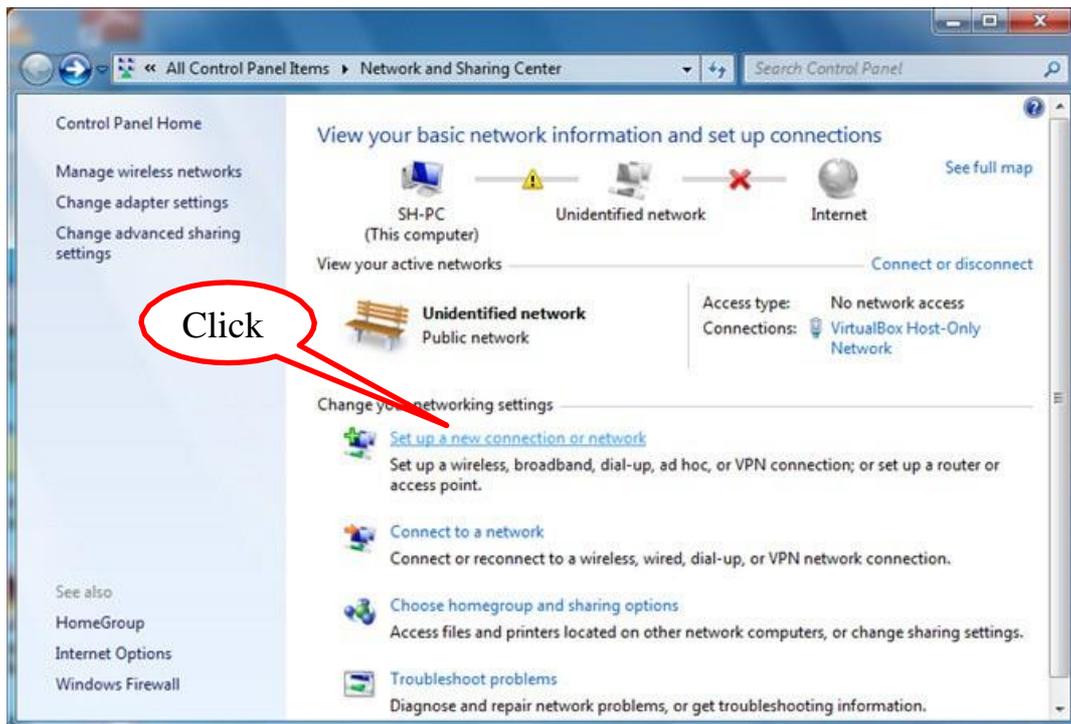

4. Under “Choose a connection option”, click on “Manually connect to a wireless network”. Click the “Next” button.

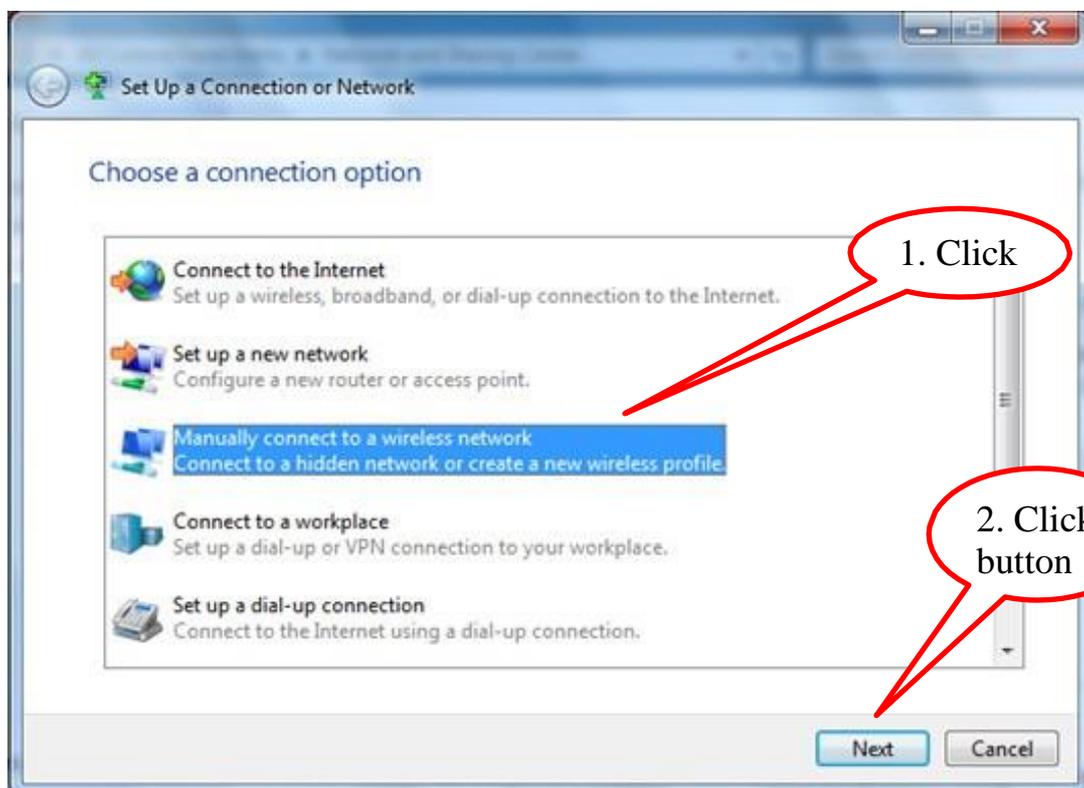

5. In the next window, enter and set each option as shown in Figure 5. Click the “Next” button.

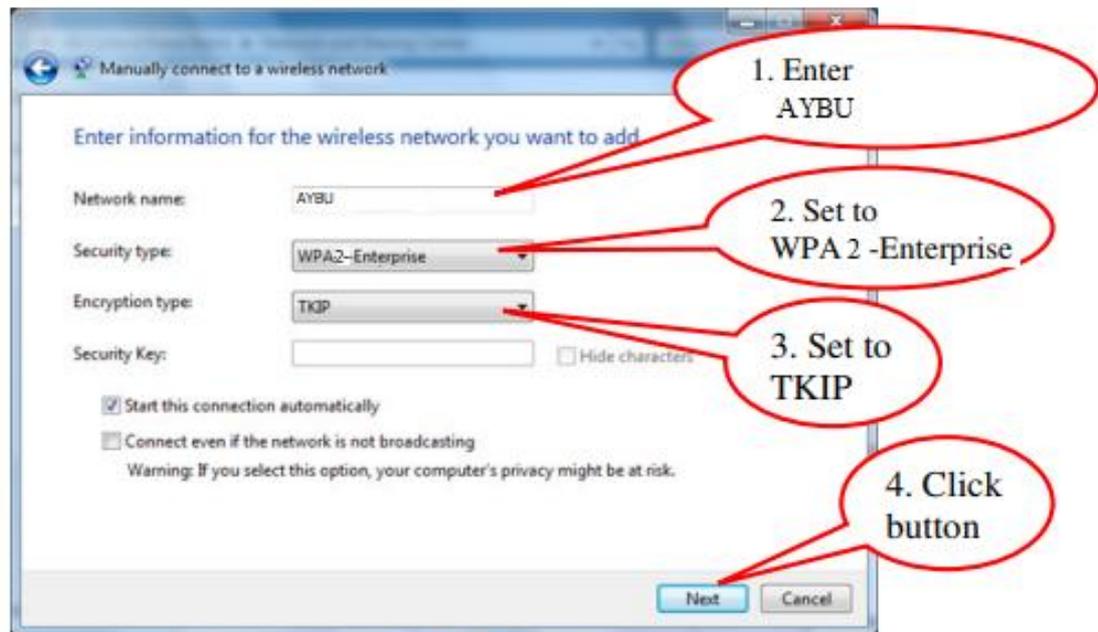

6. At the next screen, click on “Change connection settings”.

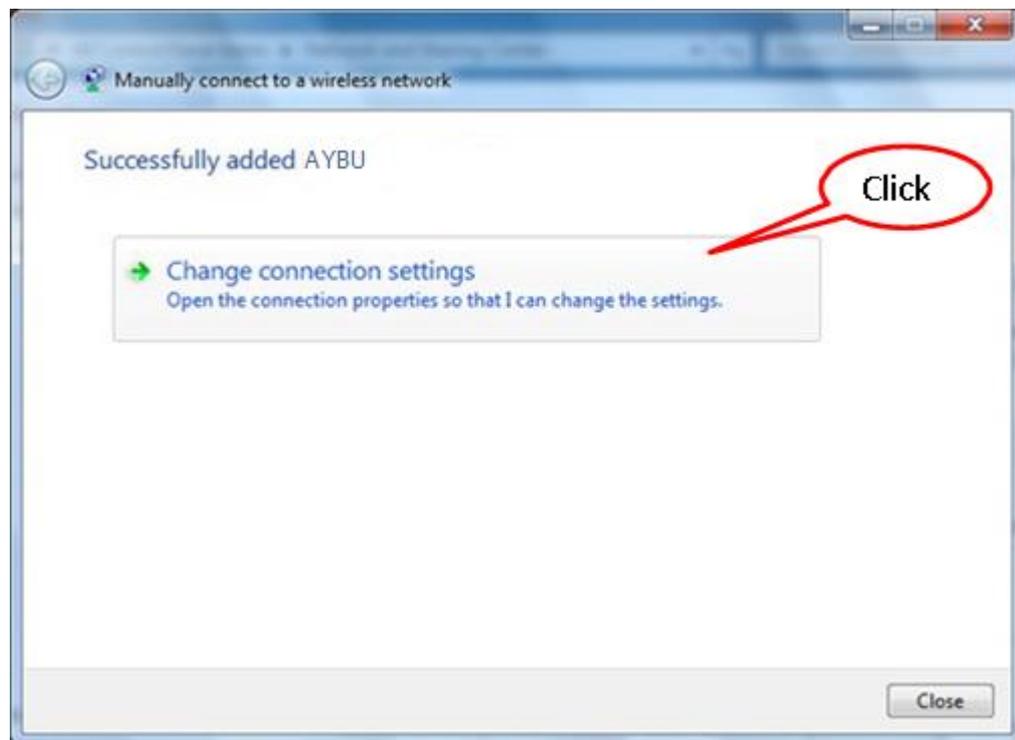

7. When the AYBU WiFi Wireless Network Properties window comes up, select the Security tab at the top.

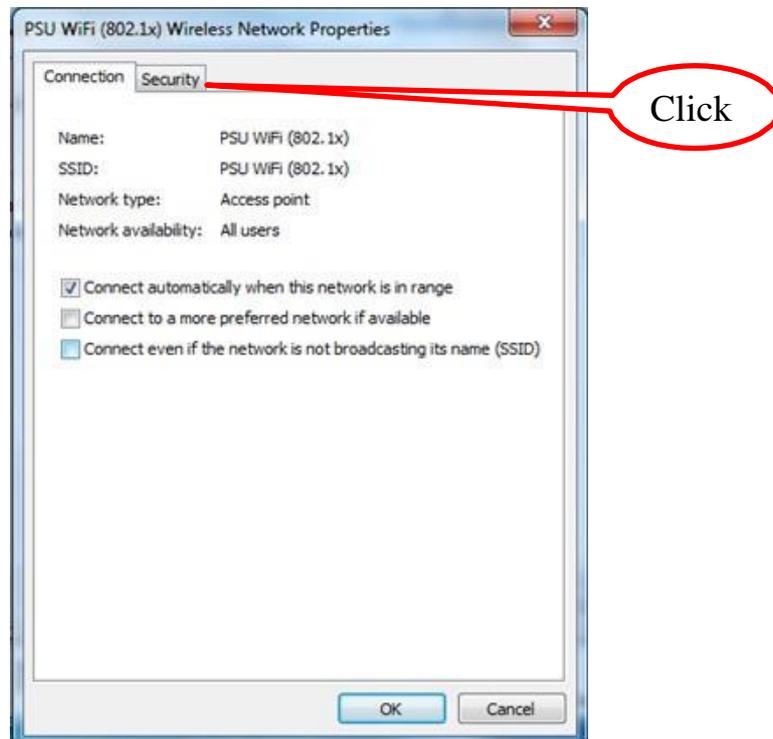

8. On the Security tab, click the "Settings" button.

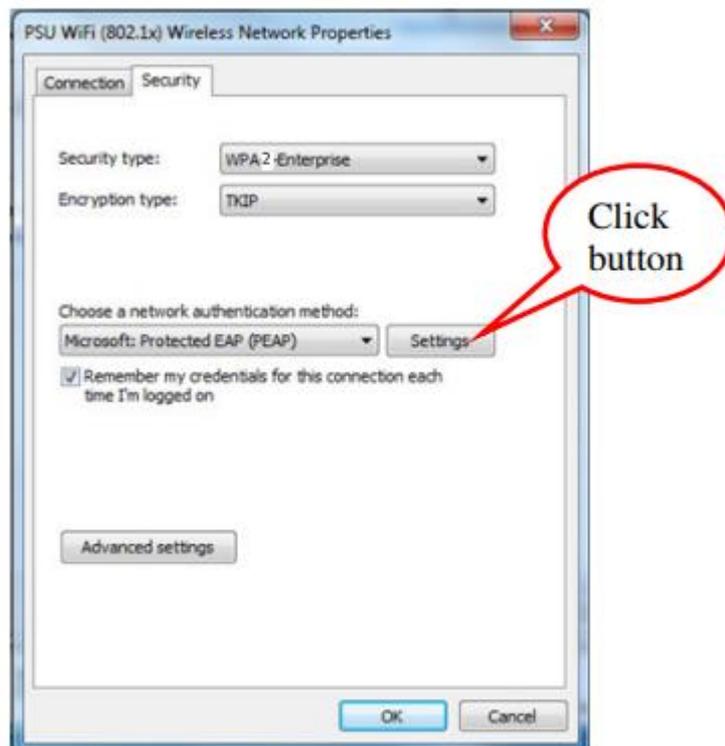

9. In the Protected EAP Properties window, un-check the “Validate server certificate” and “Enable Fast Reconnect” options. Then click the “Configure...” button.

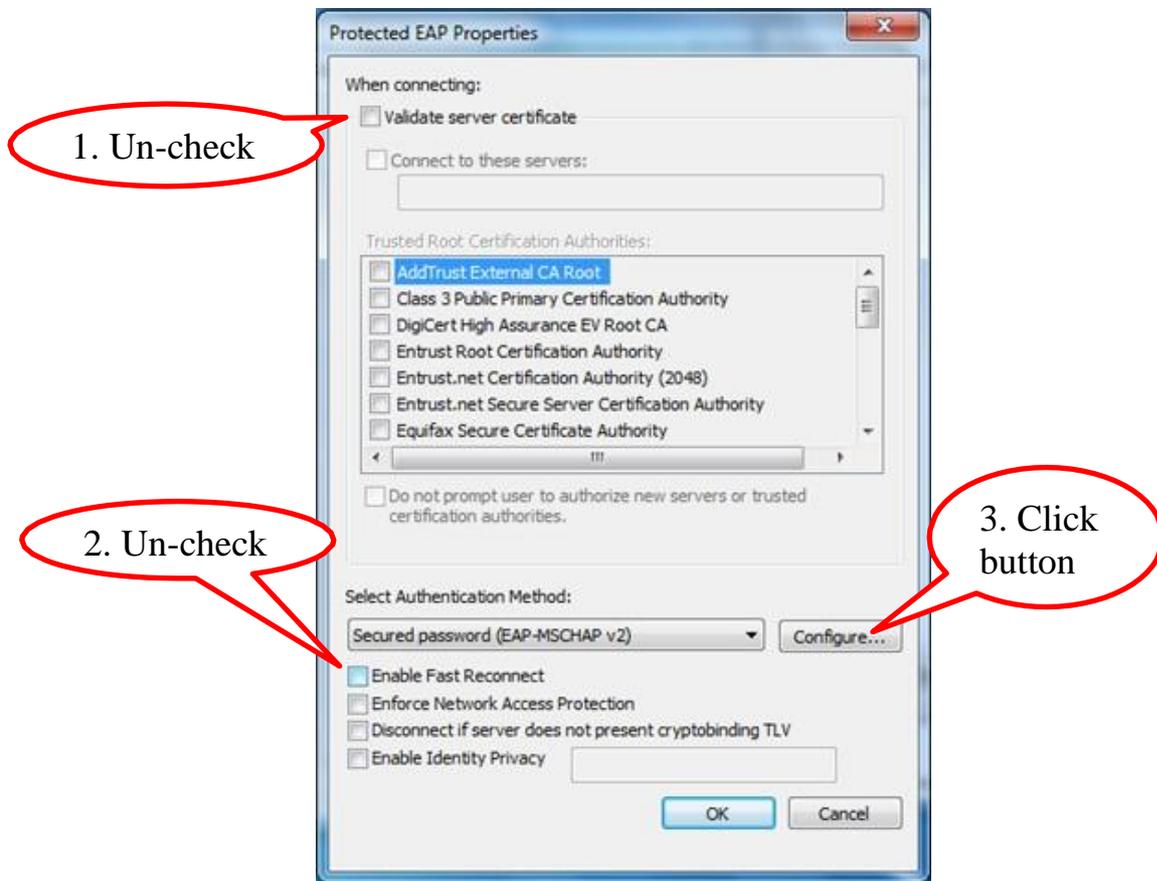

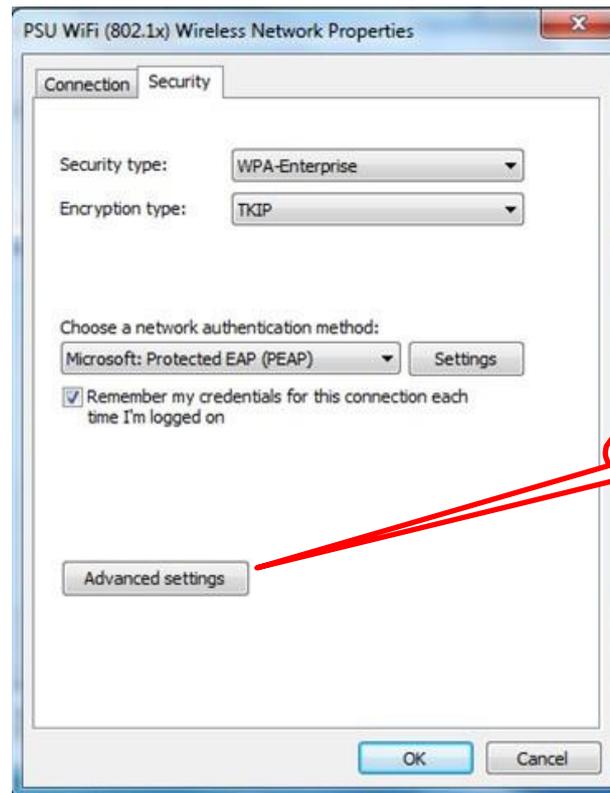

12. Check the “Specify authentication mode:” option then set the drop-down menu to “User authentication” as shown in Figure 12.

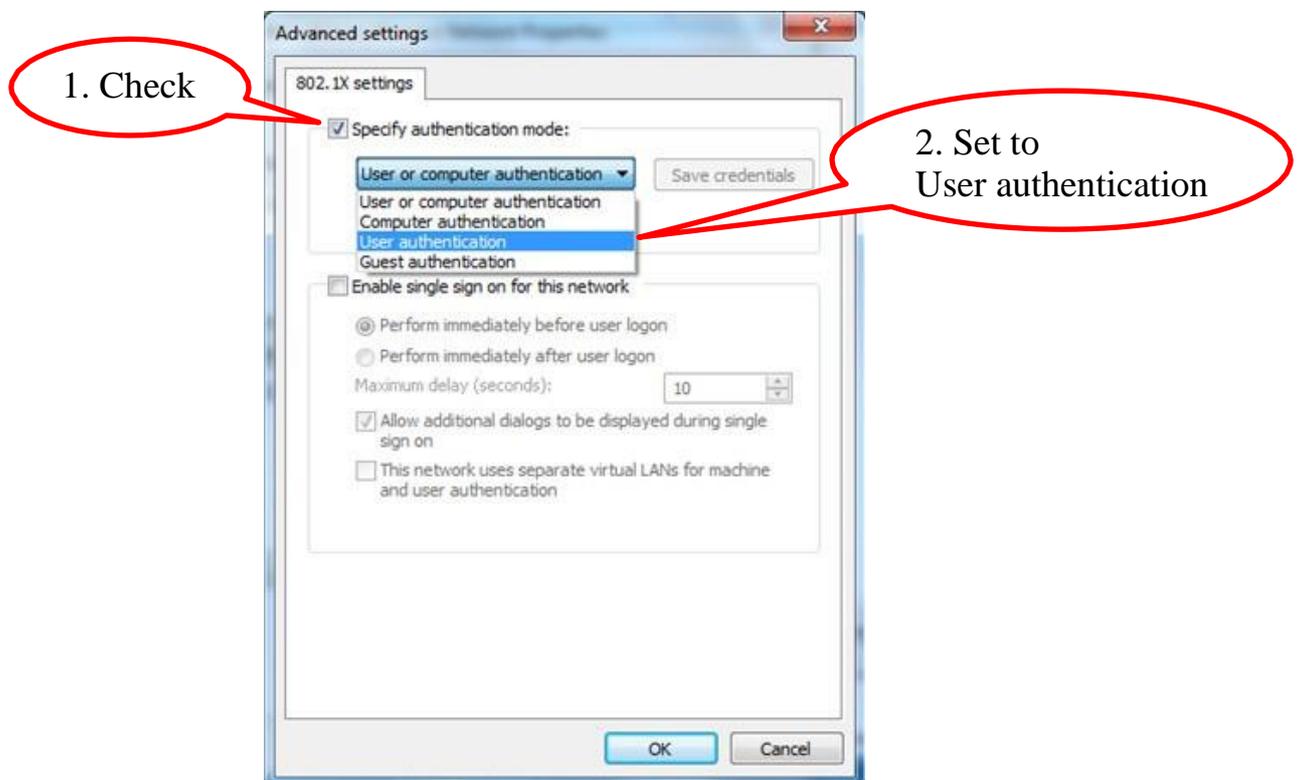

13. Click the “Save credentials” button.

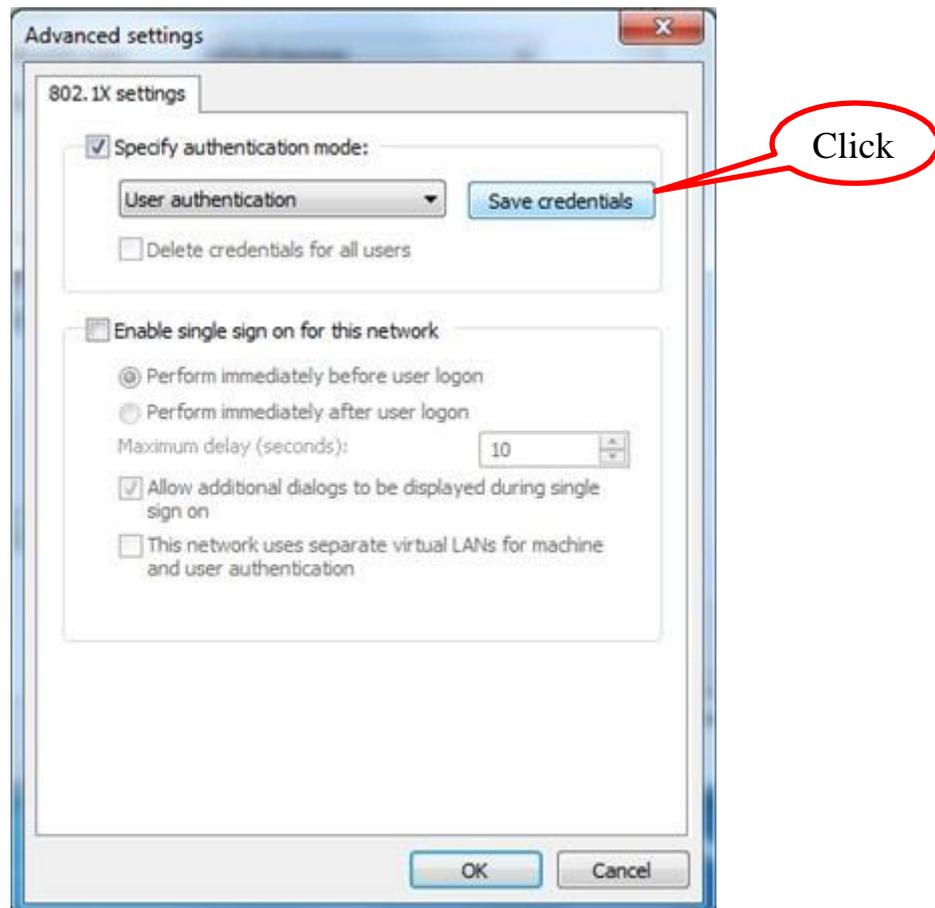

14. Enter your AYBU registration ID or student ID and password and click the “OK” button.

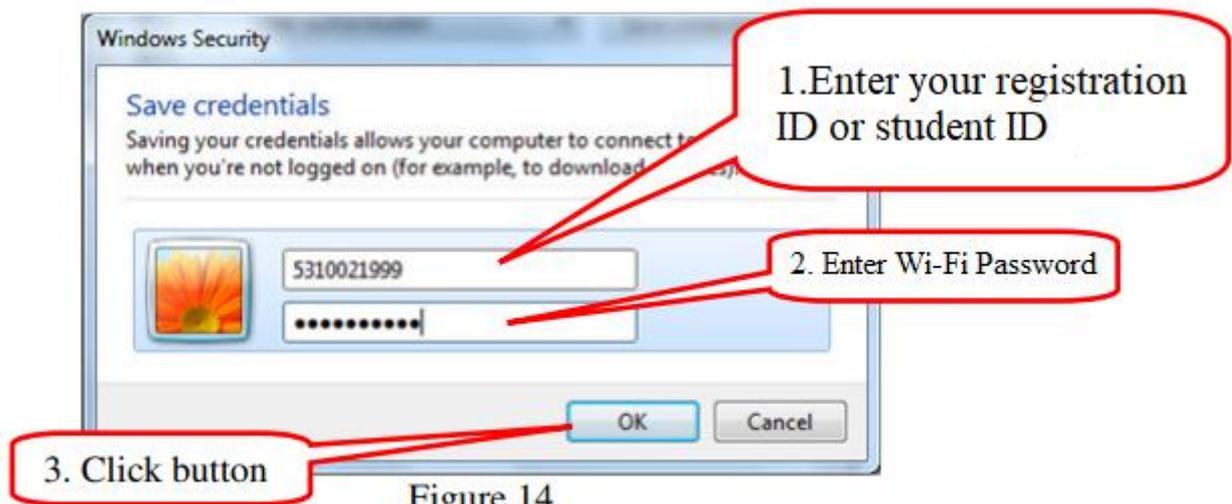

15. Click the “OK” button in the previous windows until you get back to the Network and Sharing Center in Figure 15. Click on “Connect to a network”.

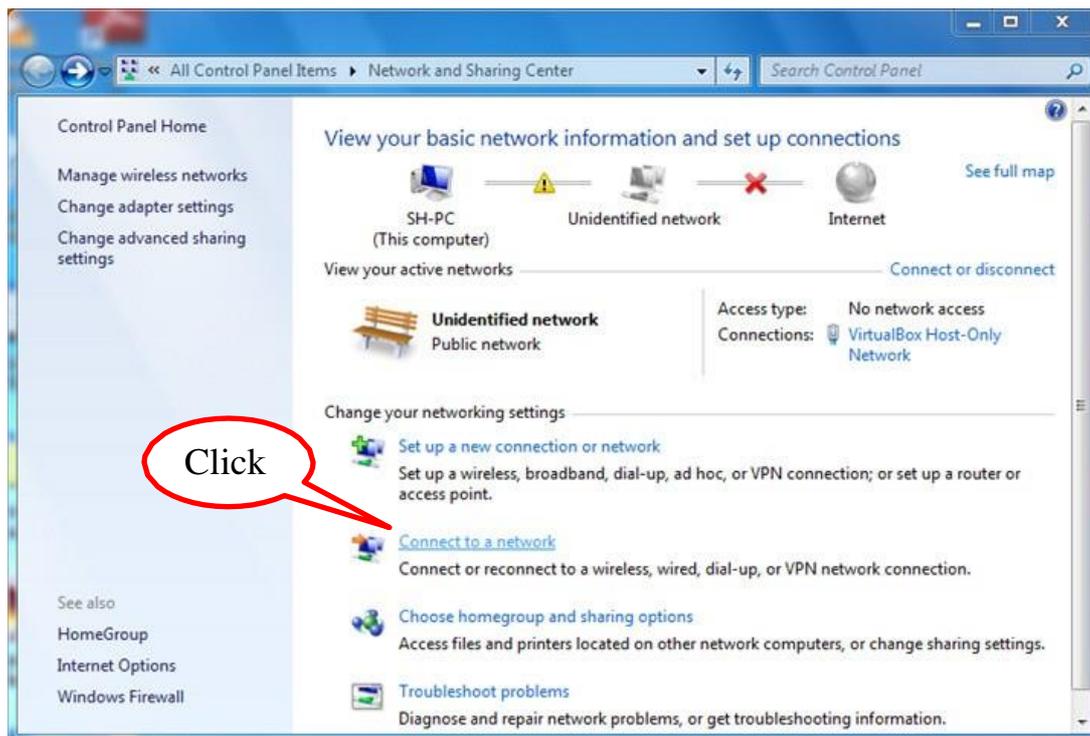
