

AYBU 2022 Erasmus+ English Language Exam Announcement for Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies and Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement Applications

Dear Students,

Application announcements for Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies for the 2022-2023 fall term and Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement for the 2022 summer term will be shared with you on our website this week.

The Erasmus+ English language exam, which is held every year/semester for these two mobility applications, will be held as a joint exam this semester, unlike the previous years, before the application process for the mobilities starts.

Those students who wish to apply for any of these two mobilities (Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies for the 2022-2023 fall term and Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement for the 2022 summer term) and who have not taken any of the English language exams recognized by ÖSYM (for the full list of the recognized exams see <https://dokuman.osym.gov.tr/pdfdokuman/2021/GENEL/esdegerlikdokuman06042021.pdf>) within the last 5 years, YÖKDİL or the English language exam that was held by AYBU School of Foreign Languages on October 20, 2021, are required to take this exam and achieve at least 60/100.

In order to take this exam, you must apply for the exam online via <https://app.erasmus.aybu.edu.tr/>. The deadline for the exam application is **1 March 2022, 13.00**. At this date and time, the system will automatically shut down and will not allow any language exam applications afterwards.

Erasmus+ language exam will be held face to face by AYBU School of Foreign Languages on **March 4, 2022, at 10:00**. There is a sample exam provided below. We recommend that you carefully read the information below before applying for the exam.

General Information on Erasmus+ English Language Exam

1. The exam will be held face to face by the AYBU School of Foreign Languages on Friday, March 4, 2022, at 10:00. Exam place, date, time, and results will be announced on the AYBU School of Foreign Languages (YDYO) website.
2. Only students registered in AYBU programs can apply for the exam. Unfortunately, preparatory class students and students with special status cannot apply for the exam.
3. Students must submit complete and accurate information. The candidates themselves are responsible for incomplete or incorrect information, and the application of a student may be deemed invalid in cases that arise as a result of incomplete / erroneous information.
4. In order to determine the number of students who will take the exam and to prevent the waste of materials and human resources allocated for the examination, 5 points will be deducted from the next Erasmus+ application scores of those students who do not attend the exam without a valid and provable excuse. To this end, only those students who are going to apply for the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies for the 2022-2023 fall term or the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement for the 2022 summer term are expected to apply for the exam.
5. The examination is free. However, in case of not attending the exam without a valid and provable excuse, a student can be made to pay the expenses made for herself/himself for the examination. (See the 2021 Contract Term Erasmus+ Handbook for Higher Education Institutions, Page: 14).
6. The result of this exam can only be used in the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies for the 2022-2023 fall term and/or the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement for the 2022 summer term applications, which are going to take place in 2022. The result will not be valid for the applications to be made in 2023, and a new exam will be held in each application period.
7. Those students who took the Erasmus+ English language exam held on October 20, 2021, can use the result of that exam in their applications in 2022. They are not required to take this exam. However, in case they take this exam, the result of the exam with the higher score will be taken into consideration.
8. Those students who achieved a minimum of 60/100 on any of the language exams recognized by ÖSYM (for the full list of the recognized exams see <https://dokuman.osym.gov.tr/pdfdokuman/2021/GENEL/esdegerlikdokuman06042021.pdf>) including YÖKDİL within the last 5 years, are not required to take this exam. However, in case they take this exam, the result of the exam with the higher score will be taken into consideration.
9. The result of this exam cannot be used for any purpose other than Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies and/or the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement applications.
10. In order to obtain a passing score, a student must achieve a minimum of 60/100 on the exam.

Application Steps for the Erasmus+ English Language Exam

1. Applications for the exam are online and will be received through the ErasmusPort system **between Tuesday, February 15, 2022 (13:00) and Tuesday, March 1, 2022 (13:00)**.
2. On March 1 at 13.00 the system will automatically shut down and will not allow any language exam applications afterwards.
3. To apply students need to follow the guidelines below.
4. Students must first sign up.
5. On the screen that appears, click on “I am a student of Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University” and then click on the “sign up” section to create an account.
6. From the ‘sign up’ page select your membership type (“I am a student of Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University”) and fill in the required information: first name, last name, email information and password. Do not forget to check and mark the “Terms of Service” and “Information and Disclosure Text” boxes before signing up.
7. A “membership confirmation email” will be sent to the given email address. Please activate your account.
8. After you activate your account you may login to the system via the following address: <https://app.erasmus.aybu.edu.tr/tr/user/login>.
9. When you log in to the system you will be asked to read and confirm the Information and Disclosure Text under the Law of Protection of Personal Data; then, you should click “Save”.
10. After the successful completion of the signup, the “My Profile” page will appear. You need to fill in the required information in the “Personal Information” section (date of birth, ID number, gender, phone number, etc.).
11. After you fill in and update the information, you need to click on “Save”.
12. Once the required personal information is filled in, you may apply for the Erasmus+ English language exam. To apply you need to choose “Exam Applications (PLE)” from the “My Applications” section on the left side of the screen. Then, you can complete your application by answering the questions on the open application form on the page that appears.
