


ERASMUS Language Exam Rules

1. Two devices will be needed for the exam. The exam itself will be taken on a computer, while invigilation will be done on a second device such as a phone or a tablet. Only one camera will be needed, and that camera must be the one on the second device.
2. The exam consists of two parts: (a) listening/reading/writing, and (b) speaking.
3. It is not possible to navigate through the pages, so the student must finish the current page before moving on to the next page. It is not possible to go back to a previous page.
4. In order for the audio to be played properly, we advise using Google Chrome as the browser. Furthermore, using a Windows computer is advised, as there might be audio playback issues on Macbook computers. If the audio does not start, it is advised to refresh the page.
5. Invigilation will be done during the listening/reading/writing part. The speaking part will also be carried out with an open camera.
6. The invigilation will be done on Perculus+ in the AYBUZEM class.
7. The positioning of the camera during invigilation is important. During the exam, the camera must show the student and the computer from the side clearly. Compare:



8. The students must be alone in the room where they will be taking the exam.
9. Students may use headphones/earbuds for the listening section. After the listening, the headphones/earbuds **must be removed** from the ear.
10. On the second device used for invigilation, the camera must be always on. If the camera is turned off for more than 5 minutes during the exam, the exam will be invalid. Therefore, it is important to check the Perculus+ screen regularly during the exam.
11. If the student is late for the exam for more than 15 minutes, the exam will be invalid.
12. The students must go in their invigilation classes 30 minutes before the exam. During this time, ID checks will be done by the instructor. For the ID check, the student must show a Turkish photo ID or a passport.
